

HELP PREVENT A WILDFIRE DURING YOUR HOLIDAY

Follow our simple tips to prevent accidental fires and keep animals safe

TIP 1

Park your vehicle in designated parking areas. Keep paths and roads clear and avoid parking in tall or dry grass.

TIP 2

Want to light a barbecue or a brazier? Make sure it's on a stable, stone surface and have an extinguisher nearby

Then we're counting on you! Follow these tips

TIP 3

Do not smoke in the countryside. If you must smoke, be sure to fully extinguish your cigarette butt (in sand for example) and do not just throw it away randomly.

TIP 4

Put rubbish in bins or take it with you and dispose of it at home.

TIP 5

Do not leave plastic or glass in your car. Sunlight on it could start a fire.

TIP 6

If you see a wildfire, call 112 immediately. Or report it through the 112 emergency services app.
